



Capture Africa – Private Mobile Tented Safari – Desert to Delta

Nxai Pans – Okavango Delta

Day 01 – Nxai Pans National Park Your scheduled flight for Maun, Botswana departs from Johannesburg airport. On arrival in Maun, you will be met by a Capture Africa delegate before boarding your light aircraft charter flight to Motopi, from where it is a 56km drive on tarmac and 1.5 hours 4 x 4 track into Nxai Pans. Packed lunch en route. (Or drive Maun to Nxai Pans, 3.5 – 4 hour drive).

We reach the grassy plains of Nxai Pan and proceed to our camp.

Your private tented camp situated under a canopy of purple-pod Terminalia trees, awaits you with tea, coffee, snacks and a well-stocked bar.

Overnight: Capture Africa Private Mobile Tented Camp (Full board)

Nxai Pan is home to Kalahari game and one of the only two areas (besides Etosha) where springbok and impala roam together. Other species that occur here are bat-eared fox, gemsbok, and seasonal migration of zebra, with predators to follow. Lion and cheetah roam the grasslands.

Day 02 & 03 – Nxai Pans National Park We spend the next two days with an early start for game drives around the vast pan. We spend a lot of time around the waterhole, where most of the action happens. In the afternoon we continue our exploration, by game drive.

Overnight: Capture Africa Private Mobile Tented Camp (Full board)

Day 04 – Maun We have an early breakfast before we leave Nxai Pan, by your choice of travel – air or road. We visit the famous cluster of baobabs known as Baines Baobabs with a picnic lunch en route.

Overnight: Lodge outside of Maun.

Day 05 – Moremi Game Reserve You have the option of either flying into Moremi Game Reserve by air charter or driving. By road the journey will take approximately 4 hours, of which the last 2 hours are game viewing. Should you choose air charter, you will fly from Maun to Xakanaka airstrip, where you will be met by your guide.

The Moremi Game Reserve offers exciting game viewing. Herds of buffalo and elephant, the shy lechwe, wild dog and cheetah make their home in this tranquil and unspoiled area. At its best Xakanaxa offers all the major predators and antelope, as well as impressive herds of elephant and buffalo. This reserve rates as one of the most beautiful in southern Africa and both game and birds are diverse and plentiful.

Your private tented camp situated in the Xakanaxa area of the Reserve, awaits you with tea, coffee, snacks and a well-stocked bar. Having settled into your spacious, insect-proof tent, enjoy lunch. Take your first game drive before

returning to camp for dinner and to relax around the campfire and listen to the sounds of the African night.

Day 06 & 07 – Moremi Game Reserve Two days of game viewing and activities by vehicle in Moremi Game Reserve.

Day 08 – Khwai Concession Today we move our mobile tented camp to the Khwai concession.

We experience a boat day trip on the Okavango Delta from Xakanaxa, with a picnic lunch on an island. The great inland delta is one of the unique natural areas of Africa. Here the Okavango River spreads out through a sea of papyrus reeds. The water is crystal clear and flows through channels covered with water lilies. The fish eagle is prevalent in the area, as are a wide variety of herons and other water birds.

We arrive late afternoon to the newly set up Khwai Mobile Camp.

The Acacia and Leadwood lined Khwai River itself is the sole source of water for miles around, and is frequented by a spectacular array of game. This is the raptor capital of Botswana: bateleur, tawny, martial and brown snake eagles line the river bank alongside lanner falcons, not only to drink in this isolated stretch of water, but also to feed on the millions of quilea which flock to the river to quench their thirst. Lion, leopard, cheetah, wild dog and hyena are commonly sighted at Khwai.

Day 09 & 10 – Khwai Concession Your days will be busy with morning, afternoon and night drives as well as the thrill of walking with an armed professional guide.

Overnight: Khwai Private Tented Camp (Full board)

Day 11 – This morning you bid farewell to your private guide and transfer to the airstrip for your scheduled charter flight to your next destination.
