

Photo Safari – Botswana

8 - 19 October, 2011

Itinerary

Day 01

Moremi Game Reserve

Your scheduled flight for Maun, Botswana departs from Johannesburg airport. On arrival in Maun, you will be picked at the airport by one of our guides. You will board an open 4 x 4 game drive vehicle. You will travel through Maun on the way to Moremi Game Reserve. Your trip will take approximately 4.5 hours, of which the last two hours will be game viewing. The Moremi Game Reserve offers exciting game viewing. Herds of buffalo and elephant, the shy lechwe, wild dog



and cheetah make their home in this tranquil and unspoiled area. At its best Xakanaxa offers all the major predators and antelope, as well as impressive herds of elephant and buffalo. This reserve rates as one of the most beautiful in Southern Africa and both game and birds are diverse and plentiful. Your private tented camp situated in the Xakanaxa area of the Reserve awaits you with tea, coffee, snacks and a well-stocked bar. After settling into your spacious 3m x 3m, insect-proof tent with en-suite bathrooms, afternoon snacks will be ready for your enjoyment. Take your first game drive before returning to camp for dinner and to relax around the campfire and listen to the sounds of the African night. Overnight: Capture Africa Private Mobile Tented Camp (Full board)

Day 02, 03 & 04

Moremi Game Reserve Three days of game viewing and activities by vehicle in Moremi Game Reserve. Overnight: Capture Africa Private Mobile Tented Camp (Full board)



Day 05

Khwai Concession Today we move our mobile tented camp to the Khwai Concession. The drive will take 3 hours, all of which include game

viewing. We arrive late afternoon to the newly set up Khwai Mobile Camp. The Acacia and Leadwood-lined Khwai River itself is the sole source of water for miles around, and is frequented by a spectacular array of game. This is the raptor capital of Botswana: bateleur, tawny, martial and brown snake eagles line the river bank alongside lanner falcons to drink in this isolated stretch of water. They also feed on the millions of quilea which flock to the river to quench their thirst. Lion, leopard, cheetah, wild dog and hyena are commonly sighted at Khwai.



Day 06, 07 & 08

Khwai Concession Your days will be busy with morning, late afternoon and night drives as well as the thrill of walking with an armed professional guide when possible.

Overnight: Khwai Private Tented Camp (Full board)

Day 09

This morning you have breakfast in camp and transfer to Savuti. The drive takes about 3 hours with game viewing the entire way.

Savuti is situated in the south western part of the Chobe National Park and covers approximately 5 000 km. The Savuti area offers great game viewing at certain times of the year. The annual zebra migration is followed by large concentrations of lion. Good sightings of cheetah and leopard are possible and the endangered wild dog also occurs here. Savuti is famous for its large concentrations of elephants that congregate around the waterholes. This makes game viewing exceptional and hides at waterholes is also a special feature of this area.

Day 10 & 11

Two days of game viewing and activities by vehicle in Savuti.

Day 12

Today you transfer back to Maun. The drive will take 5 hours, 2 of which will include game viewing. You arrive in Maun to board you scheduled Air Botswana flight.



Cost of safari: **USD 5170** per person not including any international flights and your Air Botswana flights to and from Maun.

Optional extra: Boat cruise on move day between Moremi Game Reserve and Khwai Concession. Enquire for more details.

Air Botswana details:

Air Botswana is Botswana's national carrier. It is the only company that flies between Johannesburg and Maun.

During peak season there are one or two inbound flights and one or two outbound flights everyday.

Cancellations and Refunds

If it becomes necessary for you to cancel your trip, the following fees will apply, computed as of the date of receipt of written cancellation notice, which can be sent by email, fax, or standard mail.

Cancellation Fees:

0 - 6 weeks prior: 100% of trip cost
6 - 8 weeks prior: 75%
8 - 12 weeks prior: 50%
12 weeks: 25%
